



## Using Hoopla on Roku



Hoopla is a collection of audiobooks, comics, ebooks, movies, TV shows and music. Each month you can borrow a total of 10 items (“**Instant Borrow**”) and have a total of 5 items on hold (“**Flex Borrow**”).

### Loan periods:

- Audiobook—21 days
- Comic book—21 days
- Ebook – 21 days
- Movie or TV episode—3 days
- Music album—7 days

### Hoopla can be used on:

- Android mobile devices
- Apple mobile devices
- Amazon Kindle Fire devices
- Desktop or laptop computers (Windows, Mac and Chromebook)
- Streaming media players (Amazon Fire TV, Apple TV and Roku)

### How to create a Hoopla account:

- 1) On a computer or mobile device, open a web browser and go to [www.hoopladigital.com](http://www.hoopladigital.com)
- 2) Click the blue “**Get Started**” button.
- 3) Where it says “Find Your Library,” search by zip code **46168**. From the search results, select **Plainfield Public Library (IN)**, and click the blue “Next” button.
- 4) Where it says “Connect With Your Library,” enter the number that’s on the back of your Plainfield library card and click the blue “Next” button.
- 5) Where it says “Almost Done”, enter your e-mail address and create a password that’s between 8 and 40 characters. When you are ready, click the blue “Complete Registration” button.

### How to set up Hoopla on your Roku:

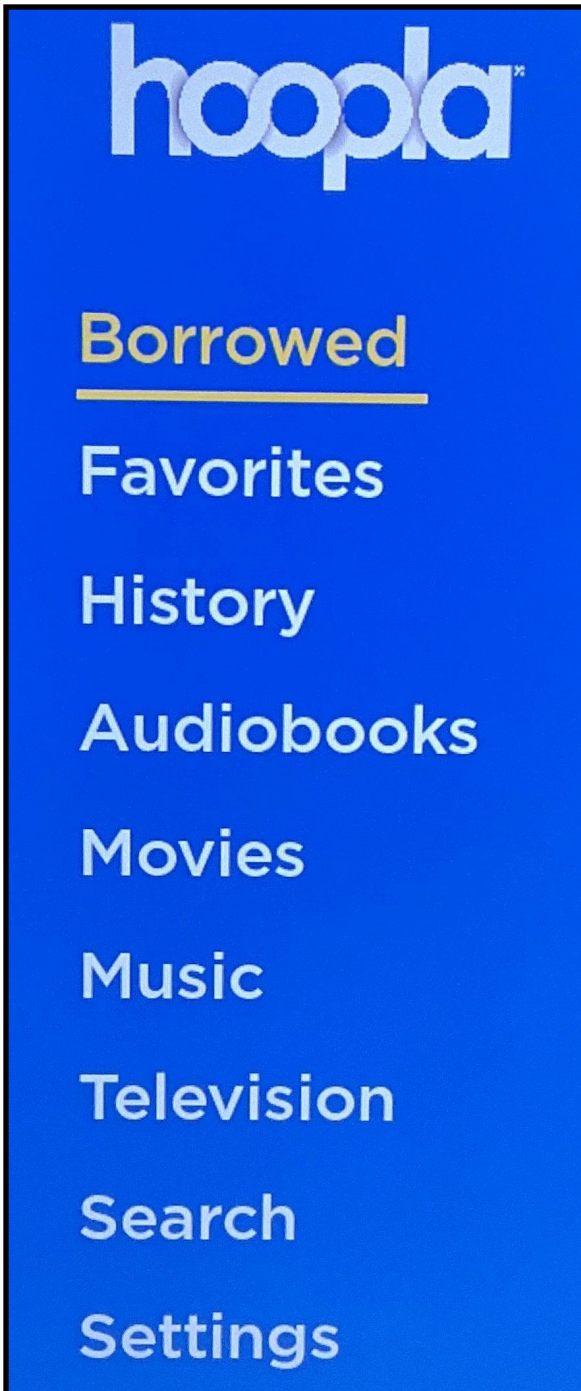
- 1) Go to the Roku Streaming Store. Find the Hoopla app (it is free) and click on “Add app”.
- 2) When it has finished installing, click on “Go to app.”
- 3) On your computer or mobile device, open a web browser and go to [www.hoopladigital.com/link](http://www.hoopladigital.com/link)  
Enter the link code that you see on your Roku screen, then click the blue “**Proceed**” button. You will see a message that the link code has been validated for your device.
- 4) Return to your Roku and begin using Hoopla.

## Using Hoopla on Roku



### How to navigate Hoopla:

There is a menu bar on the left side of the screen to help you navigate Hoopla:

—**Borrowed**—See what items you have currently checked out.

—**Favorites**—See what items you have bookmarked.

—**History**—See what items you have previously checked out.

—**Audiobooks, Movies, Music, Television** — Browse the collection by media type.

—**Search** —Search for a specific item.

—**Settings**—Turn on Kids Mode or log out of your Hoopla account.

NOTE: If you want to edit your Hoopla account (change your e-mail address, password or library card number), you must visit the Hoopla website on a computer or mobile device.

### How to borrow an item:

- 1) Browse the collection by media type, or use the Search icon to find an item you want.
- 2) Click on an item to see its details. Click on the blue "**Borrow**" button to borrow it. After it has

confirmed it has borrowed the item, click on the blue "**Play**" button to begin viewing it.
